

135 CLASS

Under 135 MPH

135 class is designed to allow just about anyone enjoy the thrill of open asphalt. The class allows almost all street legal vehicles to participate in our events. How fast you can run is determined by the level of safety you choose to build into your car.

Vehicles will be classed for records in the same manner as all race vehicles.

If the vehicle does not meet the requirements of a class, it will be designated Time Only (T/O).

Cars running under 135 MPH shall be allowed to run under the following rules:

A valid driver's license is required.

Roll Structures are not required (except convertibles.)

Fire extinguisher systems are not required.

Factory seat belts are acceptable, 3-point minimum and in safe condition.

Snell 2005 or 2010 SA or M Helmet are required.

Long sleeve shirt and pants of textile fabric and shoes in lieu SFI firesuit.

Tires rated for 135mph and in safe condition.

No fluid leaks present.

These exceptions do not include CONVERTIBLES or PLASTIC BODIED cars. Convertibles are required to have a roll structure the width of the car (head hoops do not meet this requirement) and a top.

Once a car exceeds a 5 MPH cushion it will not be allowed to run again until it is in full compliance with full competition rules.
